- Women over the age of 20 who are not currently parenting
- Women of any ethnicity, creed or religious affiliation
- Women for whom no other resources are currently available
- Women who are medically independent and chemically (addiction) free
- Women with a willingness and ability to live in a community where space, food preparation, household and grounds work are shared

Sarah's focus is providing a home, and connecting current residents to resources and support through our network of community-based service providers, programs, and professionals.

Sarah's served 43 unique women from July 2017 to June 2018.

100% are connected to appropriate resources

40% moved on from Sarah's

69% of Sarah's current residents are in school

56% of Sarah's current residents are working full- or part-time
